Description

Under close supervision, assists in providing technical support and guidance for environmental projects and programs at assigned site.

Assists in installing, operating, and maintaining environmental and emission monitoring instruments and testing equipment necessary to determine, air, land, or water pollution levels

- Assess environmental risk and assists in developing regulatory documentation of results
- Participates in performing hazardous waste site inspections and collaborates in recommending appropriate action to management in compliance with regulations
- Maintains detailed records and files of environmental testing
- Develops and maintains basic working knowledge of Federal, State and local environmental and occupational health regulations (e.g., CERCLA, NEPA, SARA, Clean Air and Water Acts)
- Performs other duties as required

Qualifications

- Bachelor's degree in appropriate Environmental Management (or related degree program)
- Up to two (2) years experience in environmental management
- Knowledge of environmental compliance, permitting, incident investigating and reporting protocols
- Able to research and analyze information of considerable difficulty and draw valid conclusions
- Able to analyze a wide range of soil, water and air samples to recognize potential environmental hazards
- Ability to develop and maintain awareness of occupational hazards and safety precautions. Skilled in following safety practices and recognizing hazards
- Ability to communicate effectively, both orally and in writing

Criteria/Conditions

- Work is in a mine or manufacturing plant setting, which may include exposure to extremes in temperature and humidity, moving mechanical parts, risk of electrical shock, toxic chemicals, explosives, fumes or airborne particles
- While performing the duties of this job, the employee is regularly required to stand, sit, demonstrate manual dexterity, climb stairs and ladders, work on elevated platforms, talk, hear and see
- Occasionally may be required to lift moderately heavy objects (up to 30 pounds) during the course of the workday
- Personal protective equipment is required when performing work in a mine, outdoor, manufacturing or plant environment, including hard hat, hearing protection, safety glasses, safety footwear, and as needed, respirator, rubber steel-toe boots, protective clothing, gloves and any other protective equipment as required
