Description

Under general supervision, performs detailed field surveys at assigned site.

- Researches previous survey evidence, maps, physical evidence and other records
- Recommends methods and procedures for conducting assigned surveys
- Prepares and presents findings to engineering and operational personnel
- Performs other duties as required

Qualifications

- High School Diploma or GED supplemented by advanced training or education in surveying, mapping or a related field
- Five years surveying experience relevant to assignment
- Knowledge of the principles and methods used in land surveys, including GIS/GPS mapping techniques
- Proficient computer skills including AutoCAD and Civil 3D
- Knowledge of and skilled in the use of a variety of specialized equipment, tools and apparatus used in performing surveys, (e.g. stadia rods, lasers, GIS/GPS units)
- Knowledge of surveying mathematics, field procedures, and operations
- Ability to develop and maintain awareness of occupational hazards and safety precautions. Skilled in following safety practices and recognizing hazards
- Ability to communicate effectively, both orally and in writing

Criteria/Conditions

- Work is in a mine setting, which may include exposure to extremes in temperature and humidity, moving mechanical parts, risk of electrical shock, toxic chemicals, explosives, fumes or airborne particles
